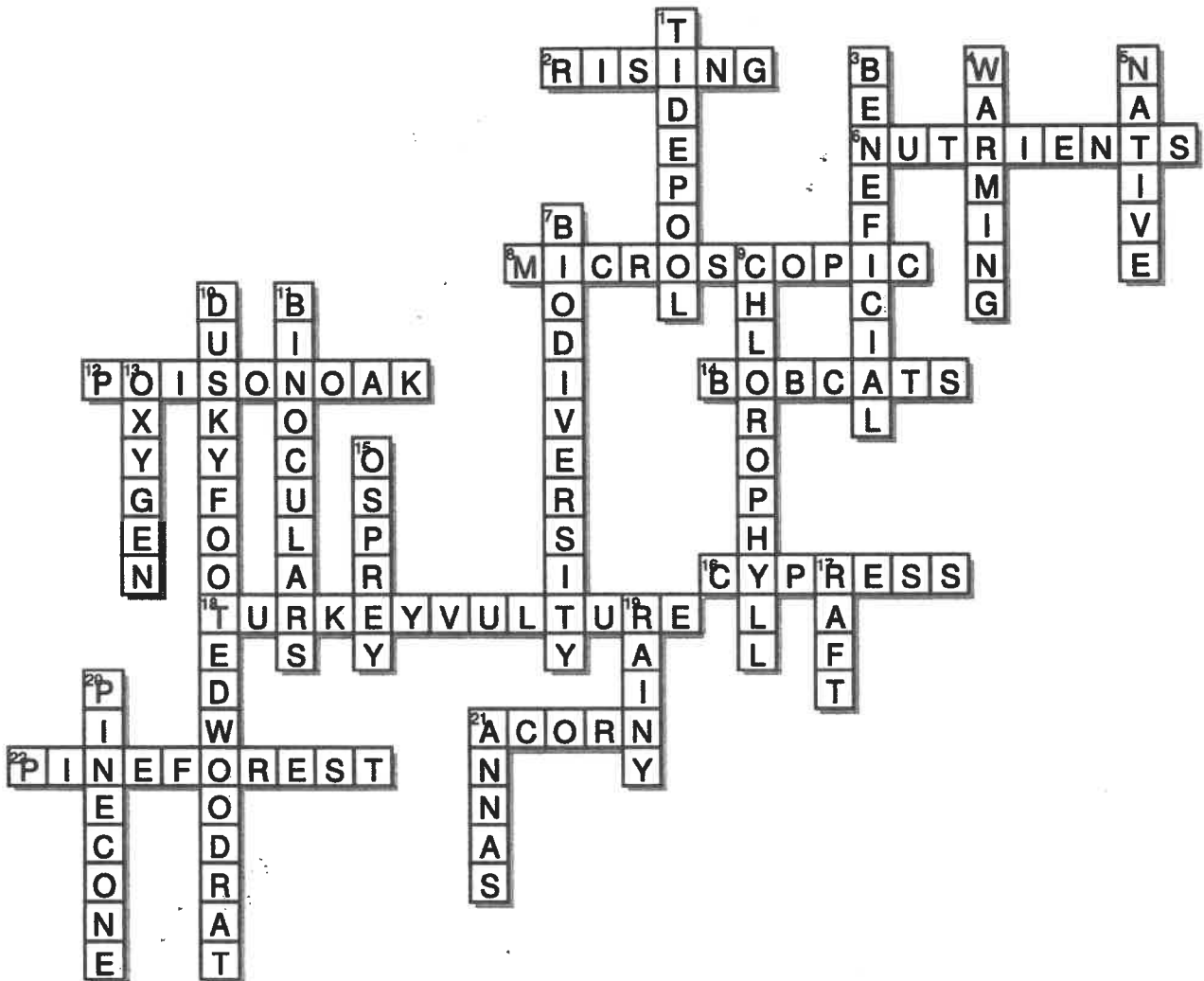


# What do you see at Point Lobos?
